During the telephone conference held on July 28, 2020, the parties consented to a bench trial and waived their right to a jury if a bench trial in this matter begins on or about January 5, 2021. If, however, a bench trial does not begin on or about that date and is instead materially

5.	Oct. 16, 2020	Parties file replies in support of any motions filed on Aug. 21, 2020
6.	Oct. 30, 2020, 10AM	Oral argument on all pending motions
7.	Nov. 20, 2020	Deadline for Court's ruling on pending motions
8.	Nov. 30, 2020	First wave of pretrial documents due
9.	Dec. 7, 2020	Second wave of pretrial documents due
10.	Dec. 14, 2020	Third wave of pretrial documents due
11.	Dec. 21, 2020	Fourth wave of pretrial documents due
12.	Dec. 28, 2020, 10AM	Pretrial Conference
13.	Jan. 5, 2021, 9AM	Thirteen-day bench trial begins
14.	Jan. 22, 2021	Final day of trial (or will be resumed much later)

Any motion to modify this schedule, even if stipulated, will be disfavored.
